General Dress Code

Clothing should reflect modesty and follow these general guidelines: Shorts, skirts, and rips in jeans should be below fingertip level with arms straight down at the sides (wearing tights or nylons under shorter lengths is not sufficient). Shirts and dresses should be modest, and not show midriffs, chests or cleavage. No strapless dresses or shirts are allowed. No underwear should be exposed. No vulgar graphics are allowed that depict sexually suggestive expressions or actions, profanity, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco, or which degrade the integrity of individual groups.
